It will focus on direct instruction and implementation of the writing standards. Being a Writer program will be implemented in grade 3-5. 2. staff will continue to be provided professional learning on the components of high quality writing instruction as well as guided reading instructional practices. 3. instructional staff will utilize HooNuit to access performance data.
